- Will be incorporated in university strategic and diversity, equity, and inclusion plans
- Performance goals set for 2025 and 2030, based on current year baseline.
- Includes 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year freshmen retention rates, 4-year and 6-year freshmen graduation rates, and a transfer student retention and graduation rate.
- Goals set across student populations by all freshmen, race and ethnicity, international, gender, Pell recipients, and first-generation students.
