




I. Research, Scholarly and Creative Activities, and Discovery

- Record research expenditures of \$196.5 million
- Record year for research awards:
 - 1,567 awards = \$161.6 million
 - 25% increase in funding since FY2016
- Increasingly diverse research portfolio
 - 291 industry-funded projects added

II and III. Undergraduate and Graduate Educational Experience

- Record 4-year graduation rate at 40.4%
- Record doctorates conferred
- Student post-graduation placement rate improved to 95%
- First ever Strategic Enrollment Management (SEM) Plan to boost enrollment and student success
- Enhanced services
 - First Generation Center for Student Success
 - Office of Diversity and Multicultural Student Affairs
 - Intercultural Immersion Experiences (e.g., Orientation and Enrollment)





- \$512.9 million invested in academic facilities since 2012




VII. Athletics

Private Giving: Innovation and Inspiration


- Exceeded annual goal with second best year for fundraising
- On target to meet \$1.4 billion goal by 2020





Private Giving: Endowment

- Increased endowment to \$539 million
- 13% increase in endowment dollars supporting scholarships





Embracing Change: Priorities Looking Ahead

- Leadership searches
 - Dean of Veterinary Medicine
 - Dean of Agriculture/Director of KSRE
 - CEO and Dean of K-State Polytechnic
- From planning to action, SEM plan implementation begins with goals to grow enrollment
 - o **In-state freshmen** enrollment numbers by 2% annually
 - Out-of-state freshmen population from 17% to 20% of the freshmen class in five years
 - Transfer cohort back above 1,000 students by 2023 (4% annually).
