### CLASSROOM ENVIRONMENTS

Code	Type	Functional Descriptions
SE	Seminar	Small discussion based, collaborative space intended to support interactions amongst all occupants
AL	Lecture Auditorium	Large didactic hall, typically tiered. Used to present to large audiences. One-way communication methods.
CA	Collaborative Auditorium	Large lecture room supporting didactic teaching methods while being able to create discussion amongst adjacent students.
LC	Lecture Classroom	Medium size spaces primarily set up for didactic teaching methods with individual, movable seating.
CO	Collaborative Classroom	Medium size spaces supporting lecture but primarily built for team (small subgroups) collaborative learning methods.
CC	Computer Classroom	Medium to large space in which the instructional delivery is primarily through technology.
LS	Learning Suite	Multi-pedagogical environment with a variety of group furnishings to create diverse, collaborative "neighborhoods" .
DE	Distance Education	Technology based supporting connectivity amongst students in various locations. Can present/share anywhere in world.
SP	Specialized Classroom	Unique space with the ability to simulate real word experiences.

### LABORATORIES AND EXPERIENTIAL ENVIRONMENTS

Code	Type	Functional Descriptions
PW	Project Workstation	Collaborative teaming tabletop environments supporting project based tasks.
AC	Analytical/Computation	Computer type stations primarily used for data manipulation and testing.
WB	Wet Bench	Traditional science and engineering bench style laboratories with fume hoods, water, air, vacuum, special power, etc.
EB	Equipment Based	Spaces supporting large equipment based activities in which the equipment is the focus.
II	Instrument Intensive	Activities focused on instrumentation.
PS	Physical Simulation	Environments creating real world experiences typically seen in the Health (nursing) and professional office practices.
AM	Activity/Movement	Space supportive of human physical activity.
ST	Studio	Unique production environments typically seen in the visual arts.
RP	Rehearsal/Performance	Unique production environments typically seen in the performing arts.
SC	Screening	Large scale media, theatrical, music review.
HS	Human Subject	Study focused people's occupational therapy, health skills, emotional disorders, etc.
SA	Speech/Audio	Language labs, hearing labs, and similar studios.
OB	Observation	Spaces supporting the viewing of activities in areas such as early education, health, wellness.
CL	Clinical	Patient service oriented typically seen in dental, nursing, and other medical programs.
AN	Animal	All types of space supporting the use of animals typically in the medical or veterinary sciences.
FW	Fieldwork	Combination of exterior spaces needed such as for agriculture, environmental sciences and any other space in support of.
OC	Other/Custom	Unique custom spaces that are not included in any other space description. Use as last resort.
