The North Texas GCSA Turfgrass Scholarship

Information for Applicants

The North Texas Golf Course Superintendents Association (NTGCSA) Turfgrass Scholarship offers educational aid to a student currently attending or enrolled in an accredited university and pursuing a degree in Turfgrass Management (or a related field) with the intentions of becoming a golf course superintendent. Awards are funded by the NTGCSA. A total of four scholarships up to \$2,500.00/scholarship will be awarded. Applications will be reviewed by an independent committee consisting of the NTGCSA Scholarship Committee chaired by Kirt Phillips (Dallas Country Club). All decisions of the committee are final. Applicants will be notified by mail of their status by January 31, 2020. All scholarship award checks will be made payable to the applicant at the completion of their internship.

Eligibility

- (1) The student must be currently working (or have made an agreement to work at) a golf course located within the North Texas Chapter of the Golf Course Superintendent's Association. The current supervisor of the student must be a member in good standing with the NTGCSA. The scheduled time frame of work must be within the dates of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020. The student does not need to work this entire time, but must complete a tenure of work, which will be reviewed by the committee.
- (2) The student must be enrolled full-time at an accredited institution of higher learning or, in the case of high school seniors, must be accepted at such an institution for the next academic year.

Criteria for Selection

Applicants will be evaluated based on the following:

- (1) Academic achievement, extracurricular and community involvement, leadership and outside employment.
- (2) One essay: Why do you believe you should be selected to recieve this scholarship? (Minimum of 250 words)

Financial need is not a factor in the selection.

How to Apply

Students must complete and submit an application form and supply the following under one cover:

- Transcripts from either high school or colleges attended
- Two letters of recommendation: one from academic institution and one personal
- Typed original essay

All applications must be postmarked by December 31, 2020
