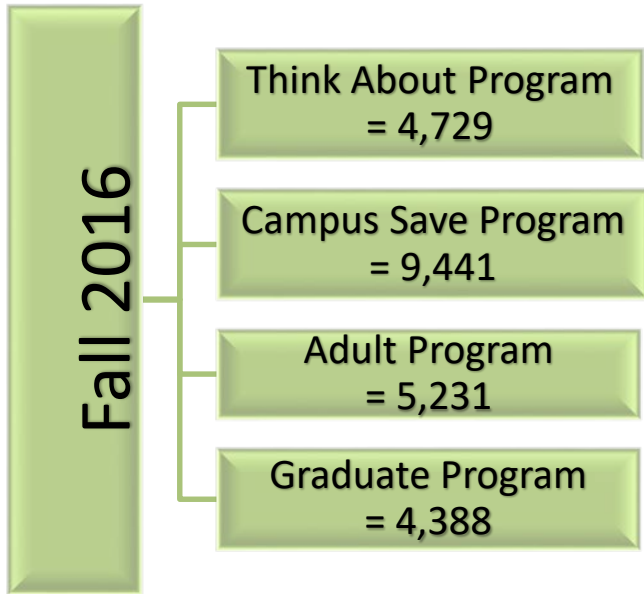

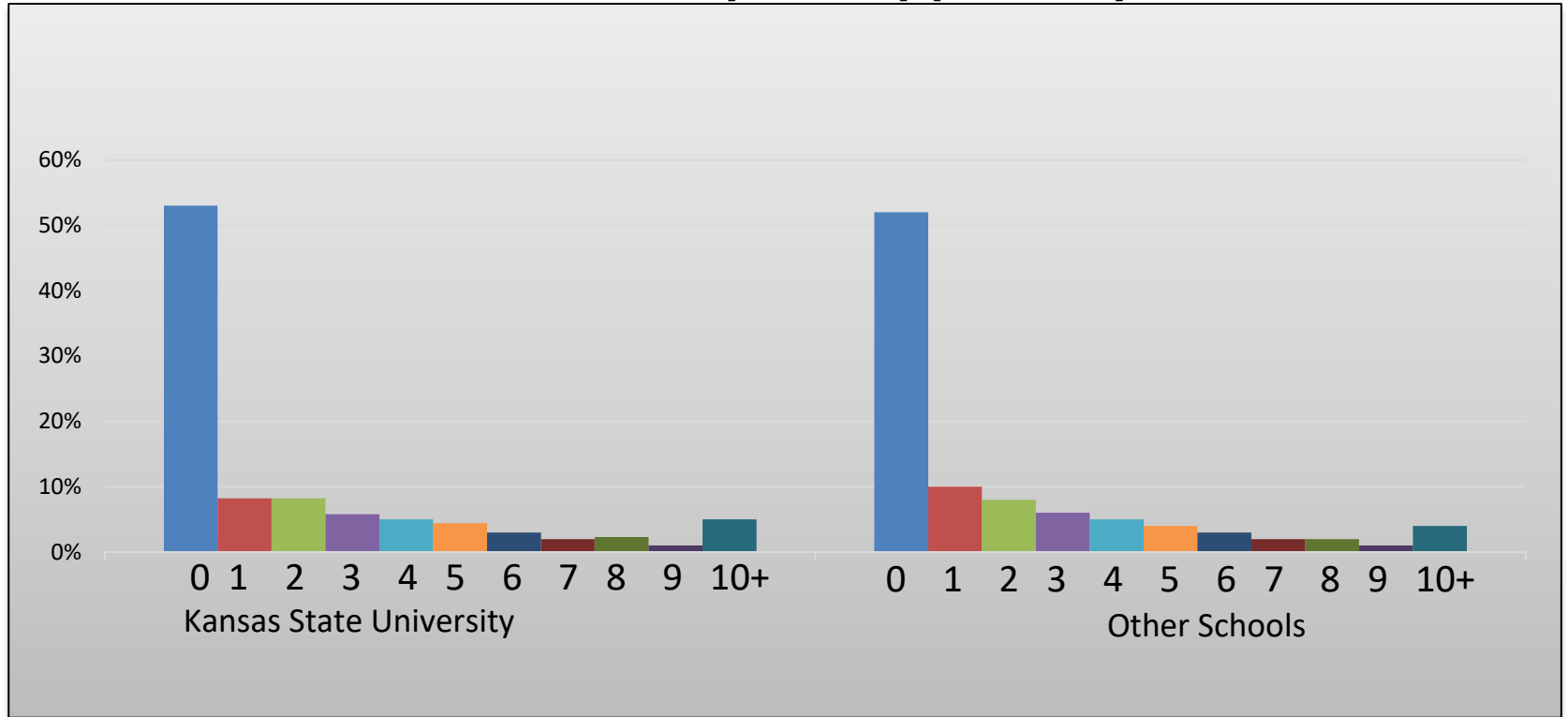


# How often do you use alcohol?

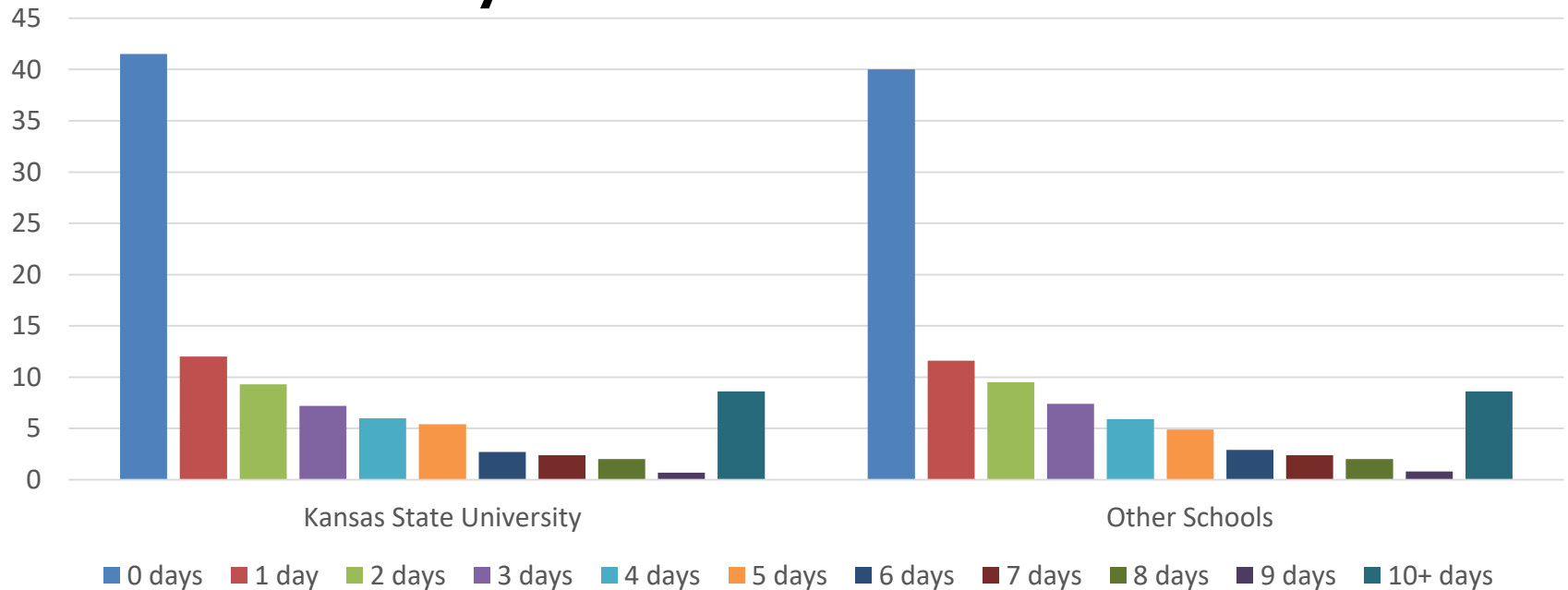
# On a given weekend evening, about how much alcohol do you typically drink?

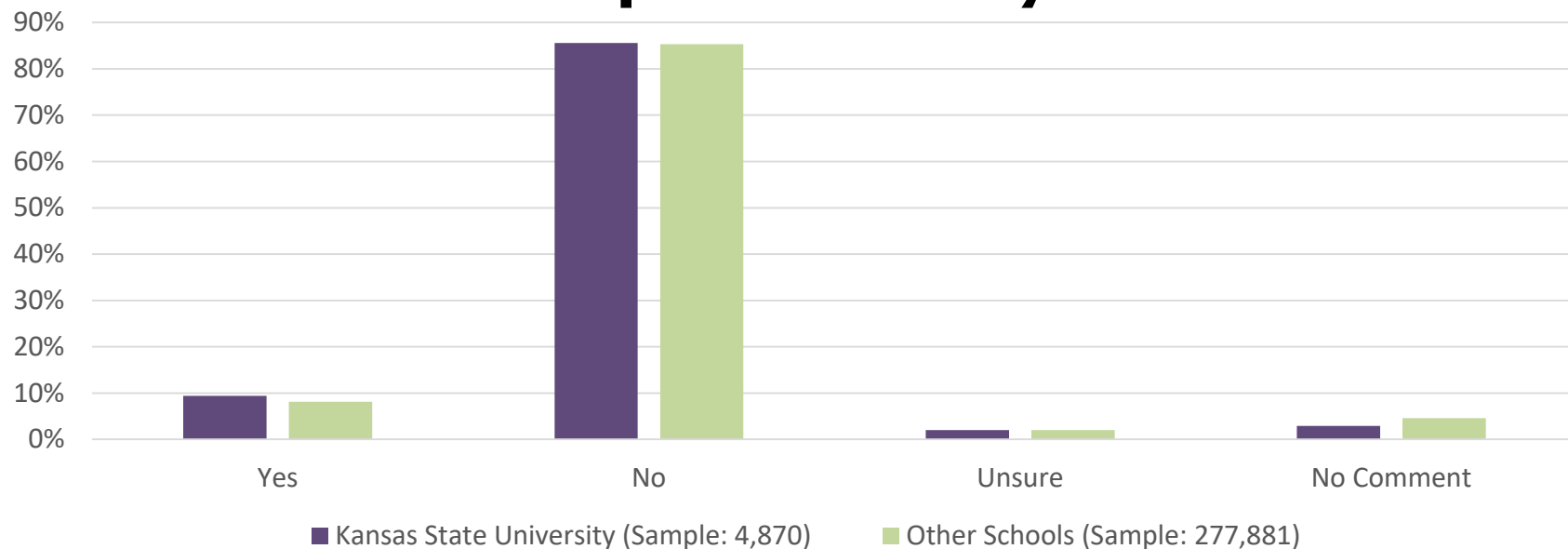


# In the past month, how many days did you drink alcohol?

# How often do you use drugs recreationally?

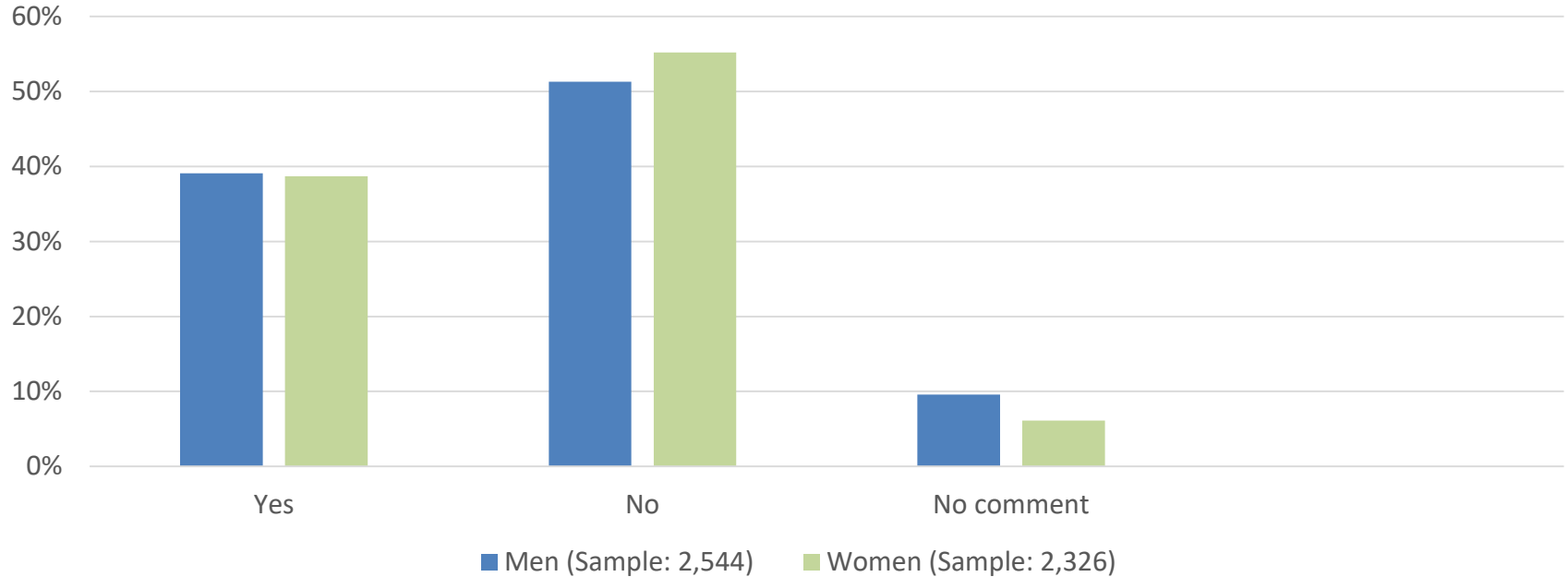

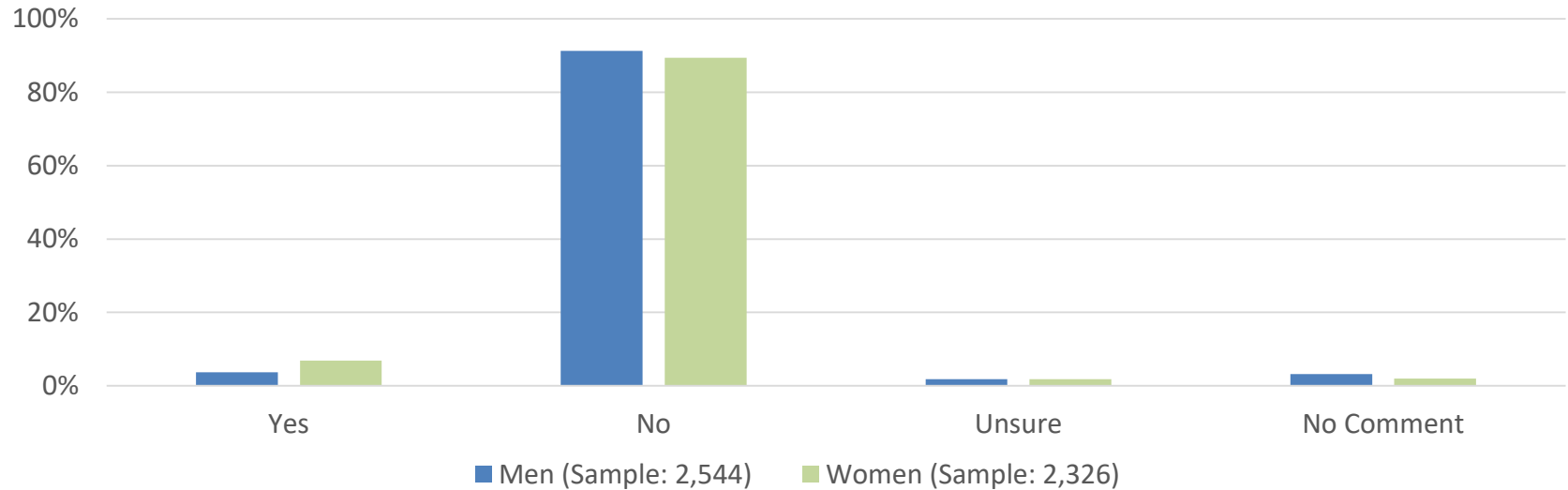


# Are you currently sexually active?

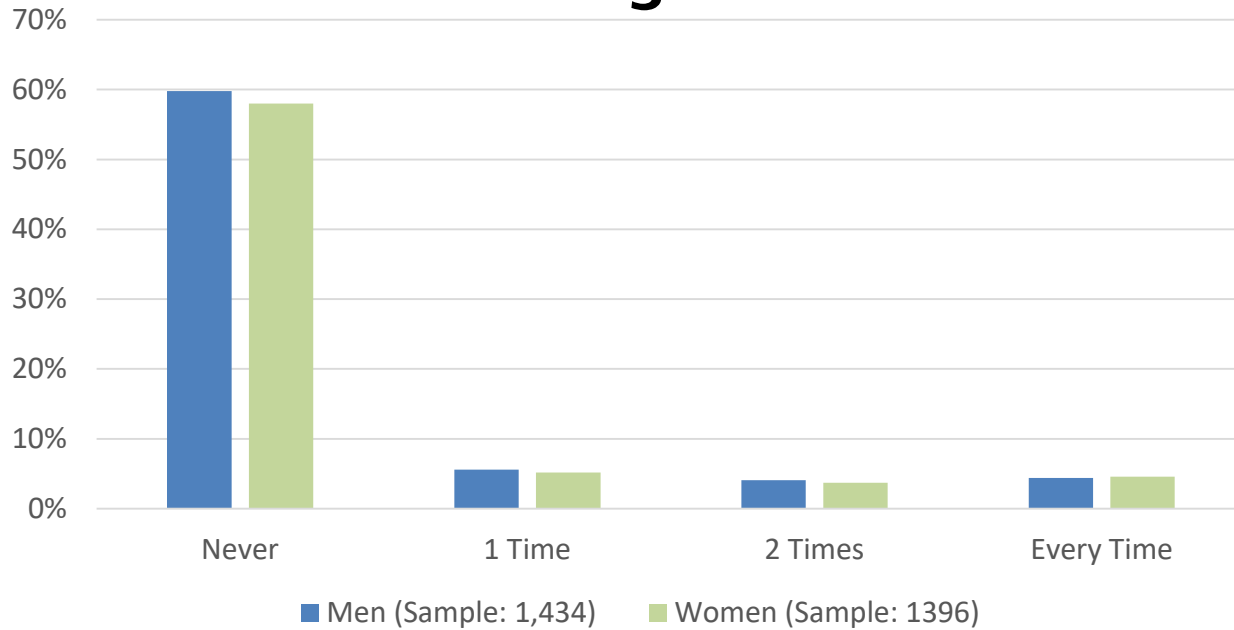
# ...Have had unwanted sex while drunk or using drugs

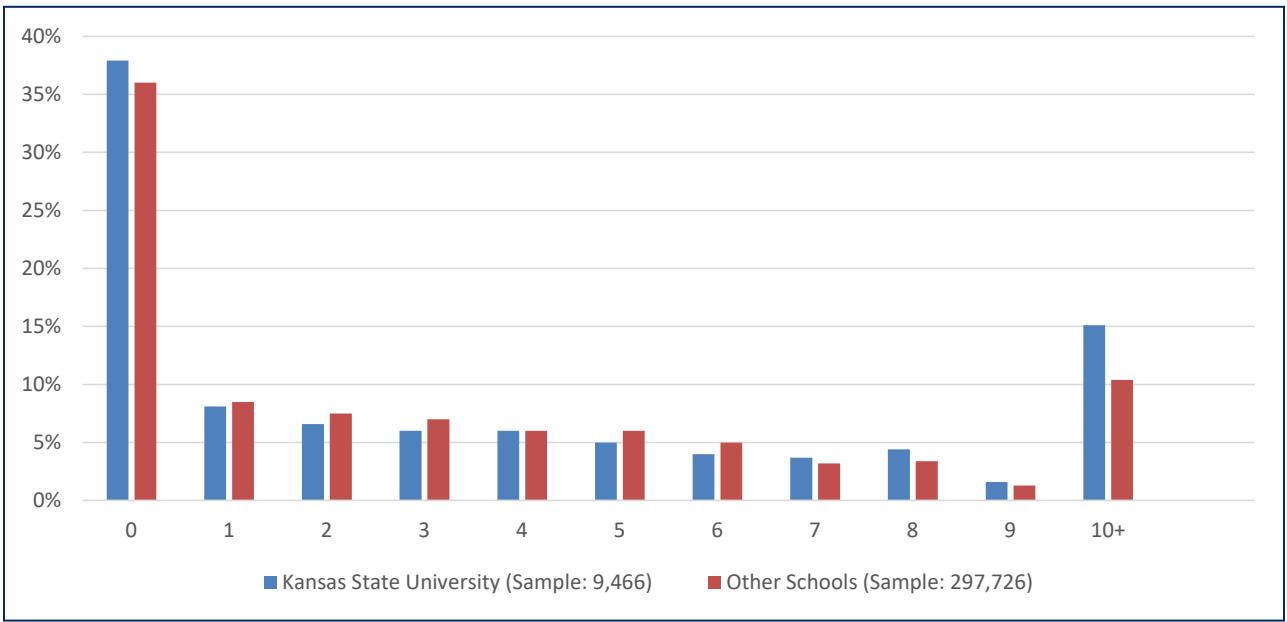

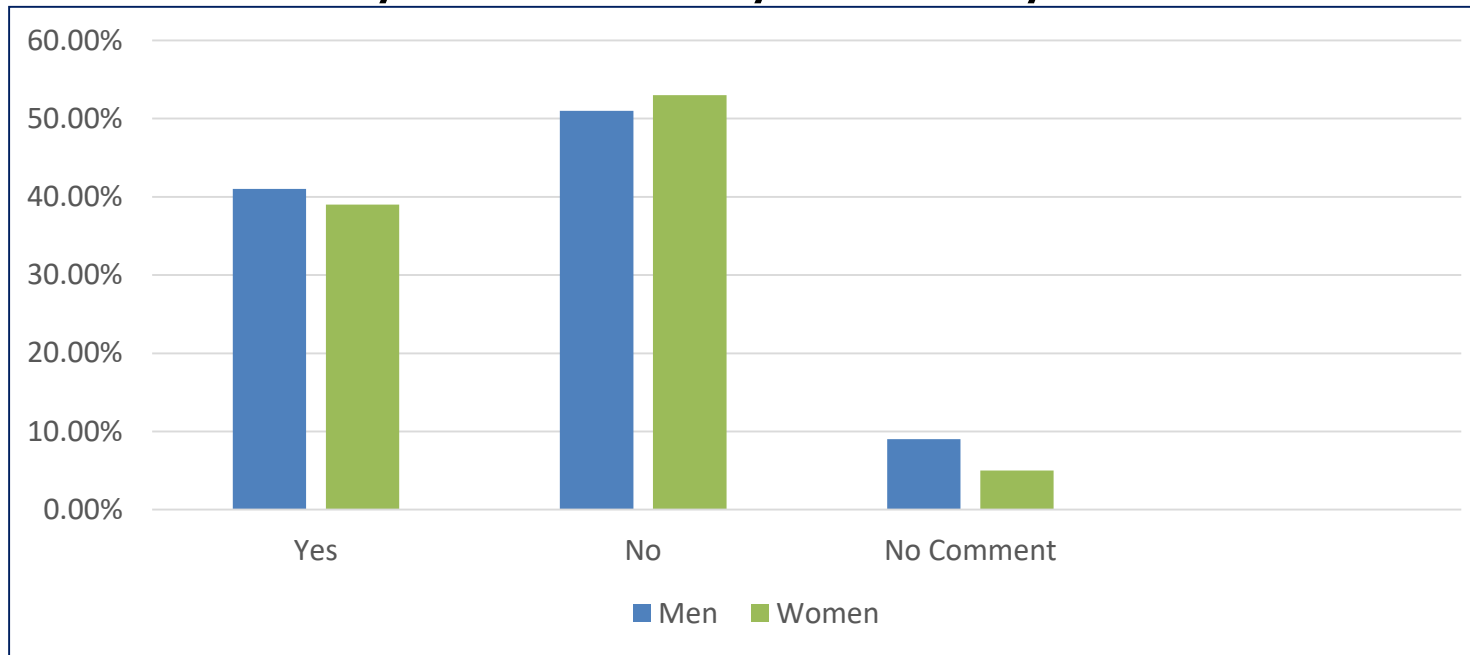


## Think of the occasion you drank the MOST this past month. How much did you drink?

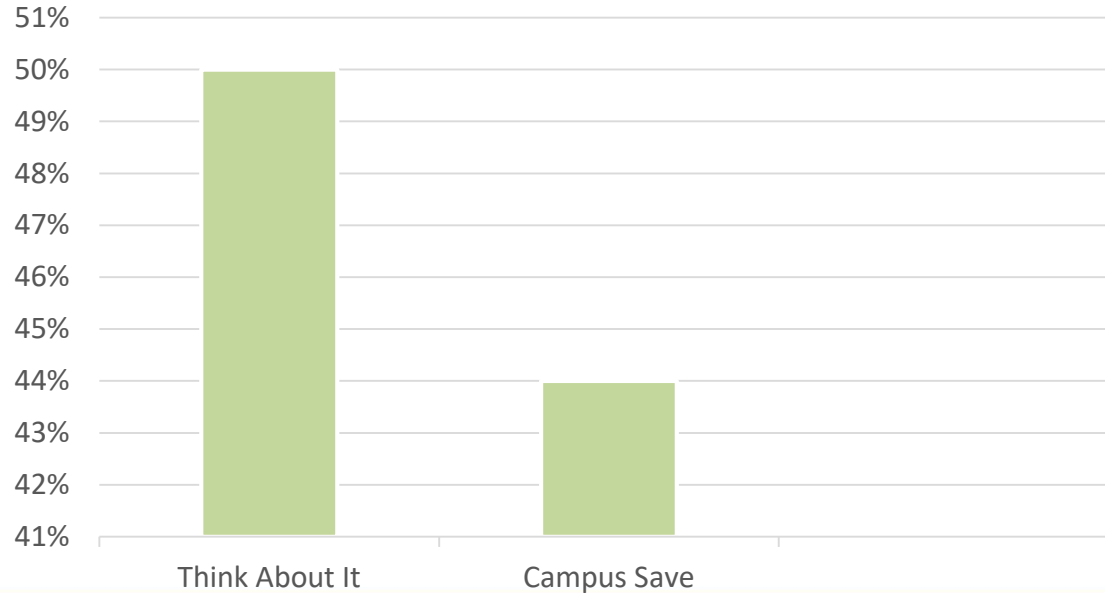
