## **Relationship Decision-Making**

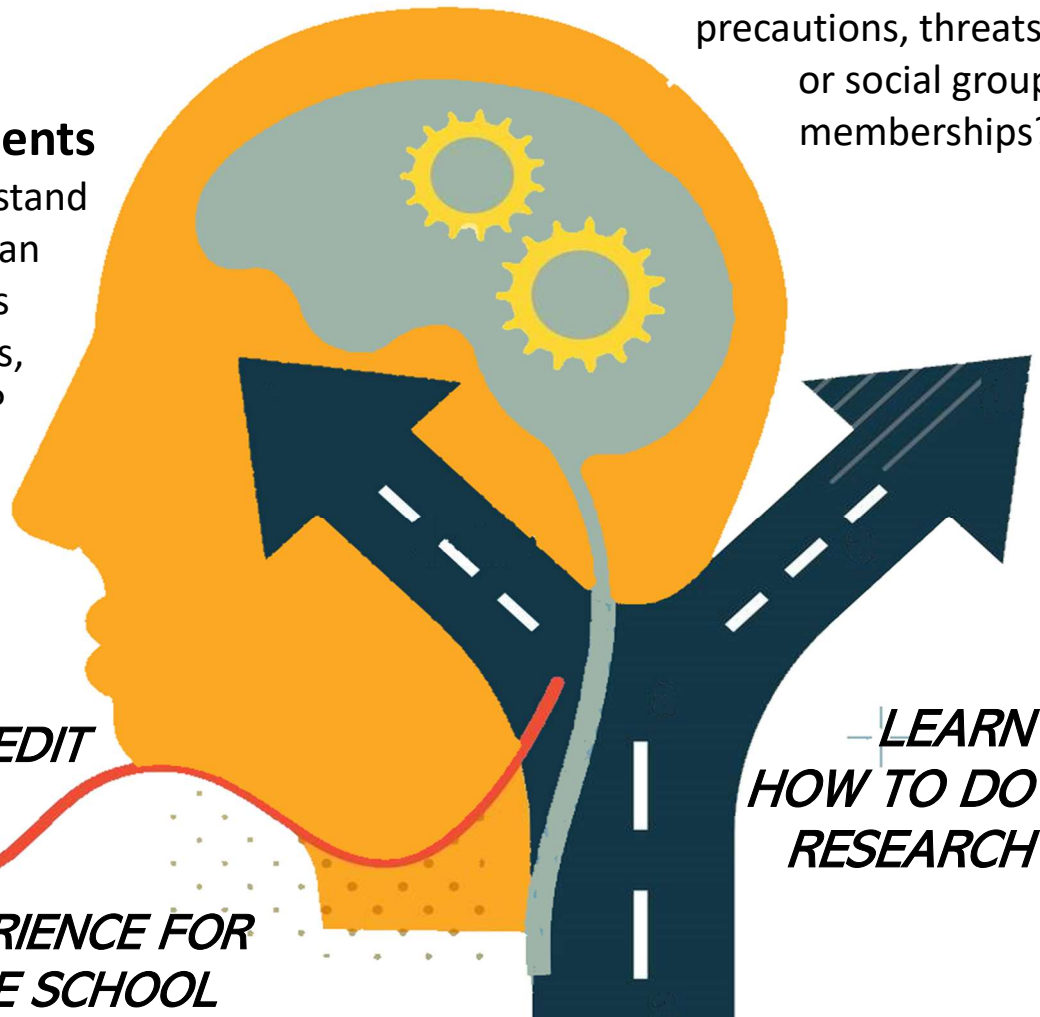
How do people assess attractiveness, express and perceive that attraction, choose a partner, and decide if/when to have children?
